1. Introduction

Jeevan Chanan Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Assandh is a Semi-rural college affiliated to Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, was established in the year 2003 by philanthropist, Shri B. R. Arora Ji in the name of his parents. This college was established when there was not a single women college in a radius of 45 Kilometres from Assandh to promote girl's education.

This college is a charitable institute which has approximately 1028 students enrolled in the college at present. This college provides highly subsidized education to women of this area and follows all the rules of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, and Department of Higher Education, Haryana.

This Institutional Development Plan includes special focus on skill based, job-oriented and entrepreneur-oriented education along with the other prior existing basic courses for the implementation of National Education Policy 2020 in Jeevan Chanan Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Assandh (Karnal). The said institute has vision and mission to provide inclusive education for all who wants to get higher education with minimum resources by providing them financial help. The said institute is committed to build strong national character of students by providing social, moral, cultural and human values with different means. This is a broad framework which will be subsequently underpinned by a more detailed action plan approved by appropriate academic and executive bodies of the college.

2. Action plan:

We would like to work on the following points: -

2.1 Academic & Curriculum Development

By offering new courses of one-year PG Diploma in Translation, Diploma in Library Science and PG Diploma in Women Studies along with existing Courses as per NEP-2020.

PG Diploma in Translation:

This is one year diploma course which has job prospects in the area of media houses, print media, script translation, tourism, foreign ministry, Indian embassy in foreign, and as interpreter.

Diploma in Library Science

This is one year diploma course which has job prospects in the area of general library management, library restorer and library Assistant (Govt. and private sector)

PG Diploma in Women Studies

This is one year diploma course which has job prospective in the area of NGOS, Asha workers, Anganwadi, Nari-Niketan, Health -centres, research analyst, social worker and women and child welfare department.

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Short-Term Certificate Courses

To introduce short-term certificate courses with 30 credits either of skilled based or entrepreneur-oriented or value-based courses for inclusive education to all students it is mandatory for each student to participate in at least one short-term certificate course.


2.2. Faculty Recruitment & Workload Planning

At least five faculty members, one student counsellor and one computer instructor are planned to be recruited for successful implantation of LOCF (Learning Outcomes – based Curriculum Framework) system of education as per required of workload. One librarian, one Maali, one Daftari and one sweeper are needed to be recruited as per recommendation of the inspection committee by Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and AICTE.

2.3. Student Development & Support Services

Regular student counsellor has to be appointed to secure mental health of students as desired by National Education Plan 2020 from this current session 2025-26.

- Library Access: Compulsory weekly library visits for students.
- Upgrade the book bank and book donation box.
- Workshops on “How to use Library and its utility” for students.
- Ensure the students for reliable transportation options
- Personality Development activities via various clubs, activities in sports, science, cultural platforms by students-exchange programs with other colleges, innovation programs, start-ups, freelancing schemes, community outreach programmes etc. are designed for students as per NEP-2020.
- Mental, Physical & Emotional Health Checkups for all Students, Faculty & other employees.
- Awareness Programs on environment, hygiene, crimes and cyber-crimes legal rights of females etc. are planned in the Academic Calendar.
- Community Outreach and Social Work Programs through N.S.S. and women cell and various clubs are planned & included in the Academic Calendar.
- Observance and celebration of important national/international days will be Organized to enhance Social, Ethical, Universal values.
- Providing value-based education through Indian Knowledge System & giving great gratitude to the contribution of Indian great personalities.
- Giving fee concession, financial aids and other helps to needy students.
- Special focus on the students who are aspiring for Competition.
- Extra Classes for those who are Comparatively weak in the class.


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2.4 Curriculum & Pedagogy

- Hybrid teaching mode: online and offline mode of teaching through smart class rooms and non- smart class rooms are planned as per NEP-2020.
- Weekly lecture via Smart Board mandatory for all subjects.
- Lesson plan and PO's and CO's will be displayed before commencement of the academicsession 2025-26
- Frequent use of ICT-integrated toolsare Compulsory for all Faculty members.
- Educational tours are organized for the students.
- Mandatory field visits and project work for all students as per NEP2020.
- Yoga and meditation sessions for all students, Faculty & other employees.
- Indoor and outdoor sports for students & faculty members.

Mode of evaluation

- Assignments, Paper Presentations, Role Reversal, Quizzes, Surprise Tests, Open Book Tests are planned for evaluation.

2.5. Infrastructure Development

- Upgrade Seminar Rooms and Multipurpose Hall is required.
- Five additional Smart Class Rooms are required
- Upgrade the Furniture where is needed and display stands and other furniture for the library
- Dedicated Board Room with AC and Smart Board for meetings of IQAC and other meetings is required.
- Construction of ramps where they are needed for accessible campus for all.

2.6 Research and Innovation

Seed money of 25000/- for the current academic session for Research and Innovation Cell as funding support is allocated for PG students & faculty members.


- Research publications in UGC-recognized journals
